Live Telecasting

1. Starting times for games will be delayed no more than five (5) minutes from the schedules starting times.
2. TV Time-out – In the event no team has called time-out by the six (6) minute point in any period one (1) TV time-out shall be authorized.
3. Half time should be extended no more than five (5) minutes beyond the normal length of intermission.
4. Post-game activities for any event shall include the awards presentation ceremony, if applicable.

Delayed Telecasting

1. There shall be no delay in the start of a scheduled contest.
2. There shall be no TV time-outs.
3. There shall be no extensions of half-time.
4. Post-game activities for any event shall include the awards presentation ceremony, if applicable.

Basketball

1. Handheld TV cameras will be allowed under each basket in a predetermined area as established prior to the broadcast.
2. With both participating coaches approval, TV cameras will be allowed on the court during an official time-out only. TV cameras will not be allowed on the playing court under any circumstances during the game with clock running.
3. Announcers will be allowed to broadcast from court side. Prior to the game and at half-time, announcers will be allowed on the court for interviews and presentations in a predetermined designated area only.
4. A meeting between TV personnel and the court supervisor (Section 2) must be held prior to broadcast to iron out details and answer questions.
5. A separate interview area will be established at the Civic Center (near locker rooms) for the use of TV, Radio and Media personnel for player and coach interviews. These interviews must be cleared by the coach of the team and information given to the floor manager prior to the interview(s).
