SECTIONALS

“BOWLING USES THE 3 CLASS BREAK DOWN”

CLASS A 600 AND ABOVE, CLASS B 599 – 300, CLASS C 299 AND BELOW

1. Sectional Tournament will begin at 9:30 A.M. Practice at 9:20 A.M. Coaches Meeting 8:50 A.M.
2. The second block will begin at approximately 1:00 P.M.
3. For eligibility requirements refer to the NYSPHSAA Handbook.
4. Each team may have 8 bowlers on their roster. Only 5 bowl each game.
5. Substitution(s) are allowed only between games – NOT DURING – unless for injury.
6. Two 3 game blocks will be bowled. Total pins will determine the overall and class winners. This is a scratch tournament.
7. In case of ties for those teams or individuals who advance to the states, a 3 game roll off will be bowled the next day after sectionals are completed. Times will be agreed on by all coaches involved.
8. USBC YOUTH and NYSPHSAA rules will be in effect for the tournament.
9. Lane assignments will be drawn before the A.M. block and assigned for the P.M. block.
10. \$6.00 admission fee will be charged for all spectators.
11. In case of inclement weather, TV Channel 9 and other stations will announce cancellation via TV and their website. You may also call the Bowling Center after 7:00 A.M., or call the above HOME telephone numbers before 6:45 A.M.
12. Cancellation policy: When the 3rd School competing that day closes due to weather, the sectionals will be rescheduled to the next date in line starting with Wednesday Feb 12.
13. School delays, up to 2 hours will push back starting time of sectionals that day. Starting time will be announced via TV and or their website. Also Bowling Center will have adjusted starting time.
14. NO HATS, shorts, skirts, dresses, pajama apparel or distractive facial makeup may be worn by bowlers or coaches during competition. Appropriate dress and appearance is expected from coaches and athletes.
15. USBC YOUTH Rule 300-c applies. We accept all youth bowlers for competition. Only those who are USBC YOUTH members qualify for USBC YOUTH high score recognition awards.
16. Buses will be **parked off site** for schools that plan on having buses stay for the day. Maps for parking will be given to the bus driver as athletes are being dropped off.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. To be held Saturday March 5th and Sunday March 6th, at Section 6 in Buffalo, NY
2. Overall winner from boys and girls High School teams will represent Section 2. Each team can bring 8 bowlers.
3. Section Teams, will consist of 6 boys and 6 girls (selected from the highest 6 game blocks from the non-winning teams).
4. \$8.00 admission fee will be charged for all spectators.
